WEARING CIVILIAN ATTIRE ON DUTY

- **a.** The requirement for grooming standards is necessary to maintain uniformity within a military population. It is the responsibility of leaders at all levels to exercise good judgment when enforcing Army policy. All Soldiers will comply with hair, fingernail, and grooming policies outlined in AR 670-1 and applicable ALARACT while in any military uniform, or in civilian clothes on duty.
- b. When civilian clothing has been authorized by competent authority for wear in a duty status in lieu of a uniform, the civilian clothing will be of the same comparable degree of formality as the uniform prescribed for such duty. Standards of dress and appearance will be conservative and meet the same high standards established for personnel in uniform.
 - a. Business Attire Equivalent to the Army Service Uniform (ASU) consists of a business suit or skirt (that is the same length as the ASU skirt), sports coat, slacks, dress belt, dress shoes, and necktie for males. Dress is conservative in color and nature. Hats will not be worn.
 - b. Business Casual Equivalent to the duty uniform, consists of a tucked in, collared shirt or blouse, slacks or Docker-styled pants, dress belt, and dress shoes. Cargo pocket pants, hiking shoes or boots, and hats will not be worn. A sports coat or blazer may be worn, Females do not have to tuck in a blouse.
 - c. Smart Casual Equivalent to the duty uniform, consists of a tucked or un-tucked, collared shirt or blouse, slacks, dress pants, chinos, jeans without visible signs of distress or skirt (that is the same length as the ASU skirt). Cargo pocket pants, hiking shoes or boots will not be worn. Hats may be worn when outside.
 - d. Casual Attire Equivalent to the field uniform consists of clothing that is clean, serviceable, and free of holes, tears, frays, etc. Casual attire consist of a collared or polo shirt, pants, belt, tactical hiking shoes, boots, or conservative casual shoes may be worn; no athletic or open toes shoes are authorized. Jeans and cargo pocket pants are acceptable. Hats may be worn while outdoors. Service members are not authorized to wear short or fashion/faded-style jeans.
